## **Chinese Minor Sheet**

The Chinese minor consists of a minimum of 14 credit hours. A minimum of C- in all courses counting toward the major is required. Half of the total 14 credit hours must be acquired through instruction at OSU. For language instruction there are three different options that are available to students, Regular class room instruction, individualized instruction and Intensive courses. Note that individualized instruction is only available for 1100 level courses, intensive writing courses, and advanced 5101-5102 courses.
