### Korean Major Requirements

The Korean major consists of a minimum of 33 credit hours. A minimum of C- in all courses counting toward the major is required. 18 of the total 33 credit hours must be acquired through instruction at OSU. For language instruction there are two different options that are available to students, Regular class room instruction, individualized instruction and Intensive courses. Note that individualized instruction is only available for 1100 courses, intensive writing courses, and advanced 5101-5102 courses.

The benefit of the intensive track is students can take 2141 and 2151 at the same time in the fall and 4142 and 4152 at the same time in the spring. This allows students to complete two years of Japanese in one year.
