Teaching of East Asian Languages and Literatures Certificate Type 3b (TEALL-CR)

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Strong teaching skills are one of the most important learning outcomes for graduate students. Completion of the coursework in this certificate will give graduate students the tools to convey the importance of East Asian languages and literatures to their students, stir excitement, and make them relevant to students' lives.

The TEALL Certificate requires a minimum of 12 credit hours made up of the following:

Required course (1 course; 3 CH)

EALL 8701: Teaching East Asian Languages at the College Level (3)

Practicum course (1-2 courses; 3-6 CH)

EALL 7706: Teaching Practicum in East Asian Cultures, Literatures, and Linguistics (3; repeatable up to 6 credit hours)

-AND-

Required: Attend one teaching-related workshop hosted by DEALL, Michael V. Drake Institute for Teaching and Learning, or other units on campus.

Elective Courses (1-2 courses; 3-6 CH)

Choose one or two of the following courses:

EALL 7700: Learning East Asian Languages in Cross-Cultural Contexts: College Level (1-3)

EALL 7701: Pedagogical Syntax for East Asian Languages (3)

EALL 7702: Materials Preparation for East Asian Languages (3)

EALL 7705: Seminar in the Learning of East Asian Languages and Cultures (3)

EDUCST 7406: Course Design for Higher Education (3)

ESEPSY 7402: Educational Psychology: Cognition, Learning and Instruction (3)

ESEPSY 7403: Motivation in Learning and Teaching (3)

ESEPSY 7404: College Teaching (3)

ESHESA 7540: Higher Education Institutions and Core Academic Issues (3)

ESHESA 7570: Internationalizing Colleges and Universities (3)

TEALL Certificate Guidelines

Credit hours required: Minimum of 12 credit hours.

Overlap with courses in degree:

- Maximum 50% overlap with courses in a degree program (i.e., MA or PhD)

Grades required:

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the certificate.
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA for all certificate course work

Declaring the certificate

In order to declare the certificate, students must meet with Jeremie Smith, Program Administrator, prior to the filing of the certificate completion paperwork and/or graduation application. Please email smith.12199@osu.edu to make an appointment.

Approval of coursework

Students who complete the certificate following the guidelines on this sheet need only verify with their academic advisor and/or program administrator that the certificate appears complete on the degree auditing system. No approval from the Department of East Asian Languages and Literatures is required.
